XENTEO® is a universal solution for unattended payment, designed for intensive use in all types of 'self-service' environments. The XENTEO terminal has obtained CB5.2 certification from the French "Groupement des Cartes Bancaires" (CB) for class 1 and class 2.1 ADM (Automated Dispensing Machine) in both PSTN and IP SSL modes. Certification for automated video rental terminals is currently underway. Additionally, the XENTEO, like all Banksys terminals, conforms to the most stringent international security standards, including PCI PED and EMV. It has also received approval from CB regarding the AFAS security standards.

The user-centric design of this terminal, equipped with a backlit display and ergonomic keypad, ensures swift transactions for all users of vending machines, kiosks, petrol stations, dispensers, self-check-outs, or unattended countertop solutions. The combination of high impact resistant polymer technology and a metal keypad produces a rugged, vandal-proof terminal, making it an ideal solution for both indoor and outdoor applications. Its clearly accessible interfaces, intuitive guidance and compact design guarantee ease of installation and maintenance. To enhance integration versatility, the XENTEO card-reader is independent from the terminal.

With its on-board Ethernet modem and modular communication interfaces for ISDN, PSTN and GSM/GPRS, XENTEO is an ideally flexible solution. The French certification in IP SSL mode allows for integration in IP solutions, delivering proven benefits in terms of transaction speed, standardisation and reduction of communication costs.

«Compared to conventional PSTN or ISDN devices, the IP solution with SSL security offers a lower total cost of ownership. » explains Vincent Roland, Executive Vice-President Atos Worldline. « We want to offer this advantage to French integrators wishing to make use of existing, faster connections, such as broadband Internet connections or GPRS.»
